**Class Fees for Non-members:** \$36 for a six-week session (drop-in fee \$8 per class) After a 6-week "basic training," you will be invited to join the local branch. Membership in the branch lets you attend classes for free and gives you discounts on social dances and balls.

Although these classes tend to be geared towards adults, younger dancers are also welcome. Please contact the teacher ahead of time if you would like to bring a dancer who is under 16 years old.

**Lansdowne Class** - There is a very small parking area at the church. There is also street parking and a municipal lot off of Lansdowne Ave. To enter the building, go to the red door on the side facing the church parking area.

**Chestnut Hill Class** - St. Paul's is just behind Borders at the top of the hill. The class will be held in the Parish hall which will be directly on your left as you walk up the driveway.
