### **Driving Directions To Swarthmore College**

Take I-476 to Exit 3, Media/Swarthmore. At bottom of exit ramp, follow sign for Swarthmore by turning onto Baltimore Pike. Stay in the right lane and in less than 1/4 mile turn right onto Route 320 South. At the first light turn right to stay on 320. At the next light turn right onto College Avenue. On College Avenue take your first right onto Cedar Lane. At the next stop sign turn left onto Elm Avenue. Turn left onto Whittier Place, marked by stone pillars. Proceed to the end of Whittier Place and turn right into the Dupont parking lot, beside the Science Center. There will be Scottish signs to help you find your way from the parking lot.
